# The right result

The campaign to turn Peacehaven & Telscombe FC into a community football club has been achieved. More than £40,000 has been raised from the share offer, £10,000 more than the minimum required. And what's more, the club has a new sponsor, global betting giant Unibet.

Unibet used The Sports Park as one of its international locations in April to film its new sports documentary series #LuckIsNoCoincidence.

It was so impressed with the welcome it received it has agreed an initial one-year main sponsorship deal with the club.

Deputy chair Sue Norwood said: "We are delighted to have sealed this sponsorship. This agreement is the best in the history of this football club."

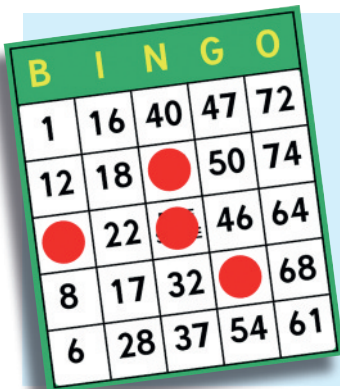

Eight games for £4 plus snowball and flyer. Free refreshments.

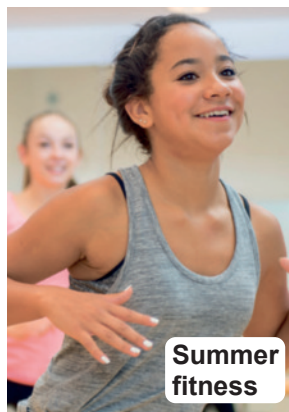
The regular monthly Friday evening cash prize bingo will be at Community House on August 19 at 7pm.

Volunteers help them by getting prescriptions or aid with shopping.

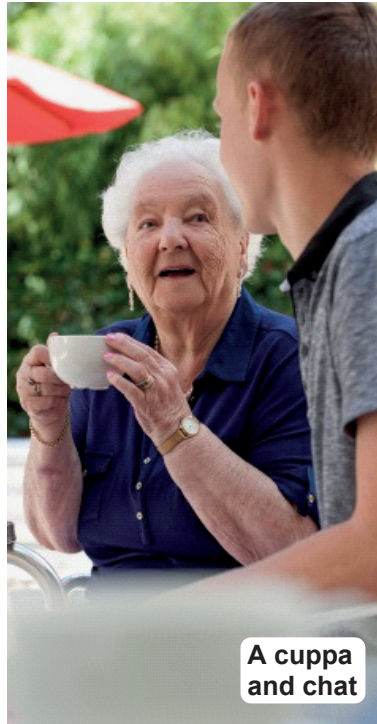
Volunteer Marie-Anne said of one woman she visits: "When I see Mabel we have a good chat over a cup of tea. She likes to hear what I have been up to and I
