Lewes citizens **SOUND ADVICE** advice District

Half of people on zero hours contracts think they are not entitled to paid holiday, says Citizens Advice, and two in five people on temporary contracts wrongly believe they are not entitled to paid holidays.

CA is calling on the Government to ensure workers are able to take the paid holiday they are entitled to after finding some employers are misleading employees about this entitlement — sometimes due to bosses' ignorance but also because some deliberately flout the law by exploiting workers' confusion. In the last financial year 185,000 people got help on employment issues.

CA wants the Government to:

- Combine the enforcement of employment rights into a powerful Fair Work Authority that can tackle employers that break the rules.
- Place a £50 cap on employment tribunal fees so people who are treated unfairly by their employer are not denied access to justice.
- Define self-employment in law to prevent exploitative employers restricting people's rights, including access to the minimum wage, holiday and sick pay.
