Dear Peacehaven residents

Last month I was delighted to revive the Quiz and Bingo Nights as part of our plan to bring back the community together and to address the issue of loneliness. Today I want to thank you for joining me in this initiative.

Through our collective effort, I am proud to announce that we have so far raised £5,676 to support the Mayor's charities. £5,333 from the summer fair, £80 from the Bingo Night and £263 from the Quiz Night.

As a Council, we are improving our web site to make it useful and accessible, especially to people with disabilities. The opening of the disabled gate in Peacehaven community garden on September 13th is a positive step toward's a more accessible town. The Neighbourhood and Business Plan teams will continue this work and influence as much as possible how our town develops to become more attractive for living, working and shopping.

Last month, I was busy representing you in events inside and outside our Town. Some local events I have attended or supported include a visit to the community orchard, the family fun day at the church of the Ascension in Peacehaven, the trophies presentation at the Horticultural Society and the opening of the disabled gate in the community garden.

Outside our town, I represented you at the recent dog show organised by Telscombe Town Council. Earlier I took part to the Dieppe Raid commemoration in Newhaven, and to the Battle of Britain with the Royal Society of St Georges in Eastbourne. I finally attended a reception organised by the Mayor of Seaford, and the pride and proud celebration by Frontline Aids in Brighton.

As you, see, we are making good progress and I look forward to the future. A future that includes working with a new Peacehaven Youth Mayor and the Deputy Youth Mayor to tackle important issues such as climate change.

ENORMOUS ESTONIAN SET TO HIT THE PEACEHAVEN RING



ONE of the biggest tag-team matches ever staged in Peacehaven is set to hit the Meridian Centre on October 26.

The bout, on a huge Saturday night Wrestling Spectacular in aid of the Mayor of Peacehaven's charities, will feature four giants of the ring, all new faces to fans of the Meridian shows, in a super-heavyweight clash that is certain to rock the arena.

They include the first Estonian wrestler to appear on a show for top UK matchmakers Premier Promotions, Timo Noot, who has trialled for the WWE and New Japan Wrestling. He goes in at 6ft. 2in. and tips the scales at nearly 17st. Even bigger is his partner, awesome Joshua James, who also stands 6ft. 2in. but weighs in at a massive 19st.

Lining up against them in a showdown that will test the Meridian ring to its limits will be a sensational new masked star, Cobalt, and the colourful Pirate captain Percy Swindels.

The tag match shares top billing on a spectacular night for grappling fans with a ladies contest, made by popular demand, between the PWF champion Amazon, recently back from a six-month tour of Japan, and Belgium-bound Zan Phoenix. Amazon, who also appeared on the WWE network's Parade of Champions classic filmed in Florida, one of the biggest events in women's wrestling history, will be accompanied by her manager and one of the most controversial figures in British wrestling, the self-styled "Twisted Genius" Dean Ayass.

The action starts at 7.30, and tickets are available in person from the Meridian Centre or by calling 01273 585493.

STOP, REPORT, TALK: BE #SCAMWARE

Thousands of people have been approached by a scammer; only a small percentage spoke to anyone about it.

Most scams reported had used offline methods e.g. unsolicited doorstep selling, mail or cold calling; targeting older or vulnerable people.

A victim may be:

- Receiving more mail than usual?
- Receiving unsolicited calls?
- Struggling with money or withdrawing large amounts of cash?

What to do:

- For telephone scams install a call blocker
- Tell the bank about any suspicious transactions on accounts or credit cards
- Report the scam to the Citizens Advice Consumer Service online or phone 03454 04 05 06 for advice on what to do next and to report the scam to Trading Standards
- Report the scam to Action Fraud tel.0300 123 2040
- Help how to pay bills or outstanding debts suggest they visit their local Citizens Advice

Always:

- Be suspicious if contacted out of the blue
- If it sounds too good to be true it probably is
- Never send money to someone you've never met
- Never give out bank details unless certain you can trust the person contacting you
- Never make a decision straight away; if you feel pressured say "no"
- Telephone scam? Hang up, wait five minutes to clear the line, use another phone
- Don't suffer in silence – speak out about scams

COMMUNITY SPEEDWATCH SCHEME

HELP REDUCE DEATH AND INJURY ON OUR ROADS

Community Speedwatch is looking for volunteers to help join your local Community Scheme. Full training will be given for this role by Sussex Police. This is a vital role in helping to reduce anti-social driving and helping to prevent death and injury on our roads.

Community Speedwatch (CSW) is a national initiative where active members of local communities join with the support of the Police to monitor speeds of vehicles using speed detection devices. Vehicles exceeding the speed limit are referred to the Police with the aim of educating drivers to re-duce their speeds. In cases where education is blatantly ignored and evidence of repeat or excessive offences is collated (even across county borders), enforcement and prosecution follow.
