### Peacehaven and Telscombe Bowls Club

**It was resolved to recommend a grant of £750** A Grant was awarded to support the repair of the Community bowling green due to damage caused by leatherjacket grubs and return the lawn to a playable condition.

### CTLA

### Peacehaven & Telscombe Football Club

**It was resolved to recommend a grant of £750** to enable the club to continue offering development in grass roots football and to help with training and development of Peacehaven children in football.

### Kempton House Day Centre
