

Officers: Zoe Polydorou (Meetings & Projects Officer), Vicky Onis (Committees & Assistant Projects Officer)

No members of the public were in attendance.

1 PH2431 CHAIR ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Chair ran through the Civility and Respect statement, explained the fire procedure, reminded committee of the mobile phone protocol, that the meeting was being recorded, and reminded committee of the confidential session protocol.

The Chair expressed help was needed for bingo on 29th October.

- 2 PH2432 PUBLIC QUESTIONS There will be a 15-minute period whereby members of the public may ask questions on any relevant Planning & Highways matter.

 There were no public questions.
- 3 PH2433 TO CONSIDER APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE & SUBSTITUTIONS
 Apologies were received from Cllr Sharkey, and also Cllr Davies Cllr Gallagher substituted.
- 4 PH2434 TO RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST FROM COMMITTEE MEMBERS
 There were no declarations of interest.
- 5 PH2435 TO ADOPT THE MINUTES FROM THE 7TH OCTOBER 2025 Proposed by: Cllr Rosser Seconded by: Cllr Wood Committee resolved to adopt the minutes.
- 6 PH2436 TO NOTE AND REVIEW THE COMMITTEES BUDGETARY REPORT The budgetary report was **noted**.
- 7 PH2437 TO DISCUSS AND AGREE PLANNING BUDGET REQUIREMENTS FOR 2026/27
 The Chair apologised there was not a paper, and expressed there would be an update at the next committee.

8 PH2438 TO RECEIVE AN UPDATE OF THE PEACEHAVEN AND TELSCOMBE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Cllr Gallagher expressed the delay was due to the examiner's personal, that the protection of green spaces, PT14, was important and confirmed that the LDC local plan was on schedule.

9 PH2439 TO AGREE TO A PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON PEACEHAVEN TOWN COUNCIL'S ROAD SAFETY PROPOSALS

Cllr Gallagher expressed that TTC had resolved to agree to meet with PTC to discuss, and the Chair expressed an interest in attending but had limited availability.

Members discussed reasons in favour and against progressing the public consultation, citing concern over raising expectations, finances, and the importance of working with TTC.

It was proposed that committee adopt the 3 recommendations.

Proposed by: Cllr Campbell Seconded: Cllr Rosser

The resolution was **carried**. There was 1 objection.

 Cllr Campbell congratulated the Committees and Assistant Projects Officer on the report.

Meridian Monument and Area TFG
 The Meetings & Projects Officer updated committee that the information board should be ready in November.

11 TO COMMENT on the following Planning applications as follows:-

PH2441 LW/25/0560 Sweetwater 26 Blakeney Avenue It was proposed to object the application on the following grounds:-

- The application is not considered to be a variation of condition, but is a new planning application with insufficient documentation
- It is in breach of numerous LDC and NPPF policies, as well as being in breach of the emerging NDP PT1
- It is outside the planning boundary
- It is within 250m of the Newhaven boundary
- It is defined as a special place covered by a ministerial article 4 direction
- It is close to the SDNP boundary, and any light is likely to be viewable from the SDNP
- It is breach of the following NPPF paragraphs:-
 - 11 (adverse impacts would demonstrably outweigh the benefits).
 - 116 (because of the cumulative effects on road networks at a potentially dangerous junction with the A259, and because the access road is so rough),
 - 135 (it does not add to the overall quality of the area's amenities of neighbours in terms of privacy, outlook. and activity levels)
 - 139 (developments that are not well designed should be refused)
 - Is already in breach of NPPF 187e & f.
- It will change the nature of the area.
- The Town and County Planning Act para 73 does not apply because there are numerous conditions and all are valid.
- The government planning policy for traveller sites (updated December 2024) states planning law requires that applications for planning permission must be determined in accordance with the development plan, unless material conditions indicate otherwise – This policy is a material consideration, as the need for traveller sites is covered in the local plan, and if the area is going to be changed in terms of environment, air quality and noise, it can't be peacefully integrated into the existing neighbourhood.

Proposed by: Cllr Wood **Seconded by:** Cllr Gallagher Committee resolved to **object** to the application.

PH2442 TW/25/0091/TPO 3 Wendale Drive It was proposed to support the application.

Proposed by: Cllr Campbell **Seconded by:** Cllr Wood Committee **resolved** to support the application.

PH2443 LW/25/0579 Homestead Brighton Road Newhaven

It was proposed to object to the application on the following grounds, which are in addition to the objections made to LW/25/0377:-

- It is not in line with Policy DM4 in LDC Core Policy 2 because it is not an agricultural or a rural building
- It is against NPPF para 11 (the adverse impacts demonstrably outweigh the benefits)
- There are mistakes and contradictions in the main planning application for example, it states it has been occupied for 10 years, but that it is 'new housing'; that there is no provision for waste storage, but there is a septic tank etc.
- It is against plan NDP PT1 (it is not a good quality designed building), and LDC DM25 (not a suitable residential property).

Proposed by: Cllr Gallagher Seconded by: Cllr Rosser Committee resolved to object to the application.
